You will be required to provide your convention number which is assigned to you by the Convention Treasurer once she has confirmed payment is received. PayPal confirms payment right away, so is your best choice for method of payment. You do not have to have a PayPal account to use it for convention. Your convention number will be on the confirmation the Treasurer sends you. Please, please, please click on the link provided on the confirmation (where it says here) to see your confirmed registration and ensure that you are registered for everything you want. If you have questions or corrections regarding registration, email the Convention Treasurer at convention2019@corvettesnccc.org. Please be patient the first few days. There will probably be about 400 registrations received on the first day alone, so it will take her some time to work through them all.
